#### **Dues Reminder**

Don't forget that dues for International go up \$5 with your February/March annual report. (In 2023, International raised its dues \$10, \$5 in 2024 and another \$5 in 2025.) That \$5 increase should also be reflected in your chapter's bylaws. When you complete your annual report, each sister will automatically be assessed \$36 for international dues. Please be sure that your chapter dues will cover that amount and that \$36 is reflected in your chapter's bylaws. (If you need to amend your bylaws, the chapter must vote to approve the change.)

### Yearbook Requirement Change

Per a unanimous vote of the board this past weekend, local chapters will no longer be required to submit a hard copy of their yearbooks to the state secretary for display at convention. Instead, delegates may bring a hard copy to convention if they wish it to be displayed. The state secretary will have a designated display area for

yearbooks that delegates provide. Chapters will still be required to submit a copy (either digital or hard) to each member of the board, meeting the requirements outlined by the state.

### **State Goals**

Has your chapter been trying to meet the goals of showing your love as "Sisters of the Heart"? Have you done something special for one of your non-participating members? Have you invited at least two friends or family members to join your chapter? Have you sponsored a woman for one of P.E.O.'s philanthropies? Is anyone in your chapter serving on a state committee? The form will be submitted directly to the IPS Supervisor at P.E.O. International, who will confirm the \$500 donation.
